CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Brad Miller called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Vice-Chairman Tom Dinger moved to approve the minutes of the March 13th meeting as submitted; seconded by Member Robert Moss. Motion carried 5-0.

FINANCIAL REPORTS:

- A. Review of Financial Statements Accountant Kerry Swineford stated he made all of his adjustments for the 2017 year, and updated all the financials from December through March which are included in the agenda packet. D. <u>RBC's</u> – Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated RBC number seven has quit turning and is not repairable. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated eight RBC's are still functioning.
