A. Clyde Bullers

- **1.** <u>Annual Wet Test</u> Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated we passed our annual wet test at the new plant.
- 2. <u>Wastewater Plant</u> Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated work continues at the wastewater plant. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated a section of a ladder for one clarifier was delivered today. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated other than that railing, we were required to put more safety railing on some structures and they are working on getting those installed.
- **3.** <u>Vandalism on Brush Street</u> Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated on the water end of it, on Brush Street there is some vandalism going on at the pump station. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated they are looking at getting a fence around it.
- **4.** Furnaces at the Water Plant Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated at the water plant we have four furnaces that will need to be replaced, and they are not covered under warranty. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated the estimated cost to replace the four furnaces is \$15,712.00. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated for just buying the furnaces without the labor, prices ranged from \$17,000.00 to \$21,848.00.
- 5. <u>Vac Truck</u> Member Sam McKinley asked about the vac truck. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated we are holding off on that. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated they would like to bring the truck up around so we can take a look at it and do some test runs with it. We are going to wait until the temperature gets up. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated they also want to look at the old truck and see what it is worth to trade it in
- **6.** <u>Crack in the Sed Basin</u> Member Sam McKinley asked for the status of the crack in the sed basin. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated it is the same, and we are still monitoring it.
