- <u>Slip Line Project on Madison Avenue</u> Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated they finished the slip line project on Madison Avenue. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated they did 941 feet of slip lining.
- <u>Accomplishments in 2020</u> Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated in 2020 they did 1,231 feet of main sewer line replacement, added 575 feet of additional line, and cleaned approximately 5,200 feet of main line. Commissioner Clyde Bullers stated in water distribution they had 8 main line water main breaks, 11 service line water main breaks, 3 main valve repairs, 3,222 feet of main line replacement, and we received 8 new customers in taps.
