



## Attention residents of the Borough of Brookville Jefferson County, Pennsylvania.

You may qualify for housing rehabilitation assistance through the Jefferson County Housing Rehabilitation Program (JCHRP).

Homeowners who meet income eligibility requirements, reside in the home on a full time basis and have no delinquent property taxes may receive financial assistance to rehabilitate their homes.

This program is not limited to senior citizens or those with disabilities; any homeowner who qualifies by income may apply.

The objective of the Jefferson County Housing Rehabilitation Program is to address health and safety defects in owner occupied housing units. The most common types of repairs include electrical upgrades, plumbing and heating repairs or replacement, repairing broken windows and doors, structural defects, roof work, gutters and downspouts, porches, steps, and handrails. Siding and replacement windows may at times be included. Room additions, paneling, carpeting, and other “cosmetic” items are not allowable.

Mobile home owners may be eligible if their mobile home is connected to permanent utilities.
